**JustFaith (Monday evenings, starting Sept. 28)**

This program is a 30-week adult educational and formational program which offers an opportunity for participants to experience a spiritual journey into compassion. It is an extensive, conversion-based process that provides a context in which participants can grow in their commitment to care for the vulnerable and to become advocates for justice. It provides a lively and challenging format to read, view, discuss, pray, experience and be formed by the justice tradition that changes lives, inspires faithful witness, and transforms the world through love and service.

**Engaging Spirituality (Tuesday evenings)**

This program invites participants to focus on the practical challenges of following Jesus, engaging contemplation while immersing themselves in the heart of our fragmented world. It is a spiritual deepening process for Adults who are seeking to bring the power of the Holy Spirit to bear upon the needs of our world. There are 8-12 participants and the group meets for 21 weekly sessions.

**JustMatters (Wednesday evenings, starting Sept. 23)**

This 8-week module ("*Living Solidarity: Government, the Federal Budget and the Common Good*") allows a group of eight to twelve people to give sustained attention to a specific area of social concern or social ministry, with special emphasis on Catholic social teaching and culminating in a call to engaged action. Two groups will be formed—one for those with previous JustFaith experience and one for those new to the JustFaith process.

**J-Walking (Justice Walking):** time to be determined by participants

Justice Walking is a unique approach to living out our Catholic faith that brings together a small group of high school juniors and seniors with a team of adults in order to practice "J-Walking the Gospel." There are 12 sessions and a retreat. This 3-6 month process includes dialogue, prayer, pilgrimage, presentations and hands on experiences with living justly. Participation is limited to 8-10 teens.
